AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF) clinics across California provide ongoing HIV medical care, prevention services (PrEP/PEP), testing, case management, and often referrals to clinical research opportunities as they work closely with research networks.

UCSF HIV/AIDS Program — Comprehensive HIV/AIDS clinic at UCSF offering medical care, patient education, social services, and links to clinical trials. UCSF is also a major researcher in HIV treatment and telemedicine programs.
