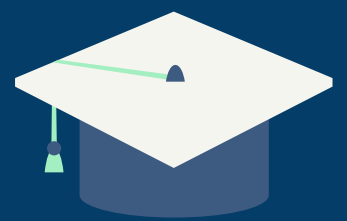
6 SESSIONS
